Subject: CE-Marking for Polycarbonate sheet

Dear Customer,

Why is it not possible to CE-Mark Polycarbonate Sheet?

In order to CE-Mark a product we need to have a European Product standard to which the product can be tested and labeled.

In CEN (Comité Européene de Normalisation) TC 128 "Roof covering products for discontinuous laying and products for wall cladding" we are working on two new European Norms:

prEN 16153 "Light transmitting flat multiwall polycarbonate (PC) sheets for internal and external roofs, walls and ceilings - Requirements and test methods"

prEN 16240 "Light transmitting flat solid polycarbonate (PC) sheets for internal and external roofs, walls and ceilings - Requirements and test methods"

prEN 16153 is now out for Formal Vote in CEN. Expectation: to be published in 2013

PrEN 16240 will be sent for Formal Vote in CEBN in due time Expectation: Published end of 2013

Once the standards have been published as a harmonized European Norm, industry can start CE-marking their products.
